During the workshop, PhD students will deliver presentations summarizing their research findings and key arguments. They will then face opponents who will provide constructive feedback and challenge their work. PhD candiates will have the opportunity to respond to these arguments and demonstrate their ability to defend their research. The workshop will culminate in an open Q&A session where PhD candidates will answer questions from the audience. This experience will help prepare our doctoral candidates for the challenges they may encounter during their official defences in the 2025/2026 academic year.
