- four-year-long **internship programme** at the Central European Academy in Budapest.

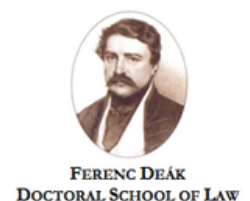

FULL-TIME INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME FOR PHD STUDENTS

PART-TIME INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

Location: Budapest & Miskolc, Hungary
Duration: 4 years (8 semesters)
Scholarship: available, application needed

FOR APPLICANTS:

The part-time fellow must have an academic affiliation (i.e. must be employed as a researcher and/or lecturer or PhD student) at a partner university abroad, or a permanent employment relationship with a foreign law research institute, or a permanent employment relationship with a judicial or public administration organisation or institution requiring a law degree. The Director-General may, in exceptional and duly justified cases, grant an exemption from the above requirement for a law degree, on prior application and at her discretion.

Location: Budapest & Miskolc, Hungary / online
Duration: 4 years (8 semesters)
Scholarship: available, application needed

Students participating in the 'Central European Comparative Law (CECL)' **English-language PhD programme** at the **Ferenc Deák Doctoral School of Law** and also take part in the **internship programme of the Central European Academy (CEA) parallelly in Budapest**. Scholarship is available in case the young researcher is admitted to both programmes.
